

HOUSE BILL 3666

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 38, Chapter 1, Part 2 and Title 45, Chapter 6, Part 2, relative to business transactions involving certain tangible personal property.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-1-203(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() The seller's right thumbprint impression. However, if taking the right thumbprint is not possible, then the dealer shall take a print from the left thumb or another finger and shall identify on the log which finger has been used. A thumb or fingerprint taken pursuant to this subdivision must be clear and complete and contain no smears or smudges. A thumb or fingerprint taken pursuant to this subdivision shall be maintained by the dealer for a period of five (5) years from the date of the sale.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 45-6-209(b)(7), is amended by deleting the following language:

As a pilot project, in any county having a population in excess of eight hundred thousand (800,000), and in any county having a population of not less than three hundred eighty-two thousand (382,000) nor more than three hundred eighty-two thousand one hundred (382,100), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, the right thumbprint of the pledgor and by substituting instead the following:

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2012, the public welfare requiring it.
