

SENATE BILL 807

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-3-102, relative to establishment of precincts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-3-102, is amended by adding the following language to the end of subdivision (a)(1):

After March 1, 2011, any precinct boundary in such county that is altered in accordance with this subdivision (a)(1) shall coincide with a census block, tract, municipal, or county boundary as designated on United States bureau of the census maps prepared for the 2010 federal decennial census.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-3-102(a)(2)(A), is amended by deleting the language " the 2000 federal decennial census; and" and by substituting instead the following:

the 2000 federal decennial census; provided, further, that after March 1, 2011, any precinct boundary in such county that is altered in accordance with the subdivision (a)(2) shall coincide with a census block, tract, municipal, or county boundary as designated on United States bureau of the census maps prepared for the 2010 federal decennial census; and

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-3-102(a)(2)(B), is amended by deleting the language " the 2000 federal decennial census." and by substituting instead the following:

the 2000 federal decennial census; provided, further, that after March 1, 2011, any precinct boundary in such county that is altered in accordance with this subdivision (a)(2) shall coincide with a census block, tract, municipal, or county

boundary as designated on United States bureau of the census maps prepared for the 2010 federal decennial census.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-3-102(a)(4), is amended by deleting the language " the 1990 or 2000 federal decennial census" and by substituting instead the language "either the 1990, 2000 or 2010 federal decennial census."

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
