

SENATE BILL 2075

AN ACT to name a Tennessee National Guard Armory in Tullahoma in honor of Command Sergeant Major Howard Boswell.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Tennessee National Guard Armory located at 1202 East Carroll Street in Tullahoma, Coffee County, is hereby designated the "Command Sergeant Major Howard Boswell National Guard Armory."

SECTION 2. The Department of Military is directed to erect suitable signs or affix suitable markers designating such edifice as the "Command Sergeant Major Howard Boswell National Guard Armory."

SECTION 3. This act shall become operative only if the cost of the manufacture and installation of such signs is paid to the department of military from non-state funds within one (1) year of the effective date of this act. Such payment shall be made prior to any expenditure by the state for the manufacture or installation of such signs. The department shall return any unused portion of the estimated cost to the person or entity paying for such signs within thirty (30) days of the erection of such signs. If the actual cost exceeds the estimated cost, an amount equal to the difference in such costs shall be remitted to the department in non-state funds within thirty (30) days of the sponsoring person or entity receiving an itemized invoice of the actual cost from the department.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
