

SENATE BILL 2401

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54,
relative to Viet Nam Veterans Boulevard.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Each county legislative body in whose district lies Viet Nam Veterans Boulevard, which is that segment of State Route 386 that runs from Interstate 65 to Long Hollow Pike, may designate the placement of signs on such highway denoting fallen soldiers from such war. Such signs shall be spaced evenly, provided they do not displace or interfere with any existing signage along such route.

SECTION 2.

(a) Fallen soldiers who were residents of Davidson County shall be designated on signs on that segment of State Route 386 that runs from Interstate 65 to the Sumner County line.

(b) Fallen soldiers who were residents of Sumner County shall be designated on signs on that segment of State Route 386 that runs from the Sumner County line to Long Hollow Pike.

SECTION 3. The erection of such signs shall be within the guidelines prescribed by the *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices*.

SECTION 4. This act shall become operative only if the federal highway administrator advises the commissioner of transportation in writing that the provisions of this act shall not render Tennessee in violation of federal laws and regulations and subject to penalties prescribed therein.

SECTION 5. The cost of such signage shall be funded in accordance with § 54-1-133.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
