

SENATE BILL 3655

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 70,
Chapter 2, relative to reduced fee or free licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-2-104(a), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision thereto:

(4)

(A) Permanent sport combination hunting and fishing license without the payment of a fee to residents of Tennessee who are under the age of eighteen (18) years and who are disabled.

(B) As used in this subdivision (a)(4), "disabled" means the inability to engage in any substantial gainful activity by reason of any medically determinable physical or mental impairment that is certified by a licensed physician and is expected to last for a continuous period of not less than twelve (12) months. This means that the condition must be both totally and permanently disabling. The director shall accept as evidence for the purposes of this subdivision (a)(4) a certificate from a physician licensed to practice medicine in this state certifying that the applicant meets the requirements of this subdivision (a)(4) with reference to being disabled.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring
