

SENATE BILL 3746

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39,
Chapter 17, Part 17, relative to child curfews.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-1703(a), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

(a) This part shall apply:

(1) Upon the adoption of a resolution by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the county legislative body, in any county having a population of not less than eight hundred ninety-seven thousand four hundred (897,400), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census;

(2) Upon the adoption of a resolution by a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the county legislative body, in any county having a population of not less than twenty-eight thousand one hundred (28,100) nor more than twenty-eight thousand two hundred (28,200), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census; or

(3) Upon the adoption of an ordinance by a majority vote of the municipal governing body, in any incorporated municipality in the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
