FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1700 – SB 1851

March 9, 2011

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004756): Deletes the original bill. Eliminates licensure and inspection requirements for persons who sell less than 30 dozen eggs produced by their own flocks per week. Requires such persons to wash their eggs.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Decrease State Revenue - \$3,500

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 53-1-208(b), the Department of Agriculture currently charges a \$50 annual license fee to egg producers who sell less than 30 dozen eggs per week.
- The Department currently licenses 70 such egg producers annually. Therefore, the recurring decrease in state revenue will be \$3,500 (70 producers x \$50 license fee).
