FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1629 – SB 1921

April 5, 2011

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005582): Deletes the original bill. Requires the organization to check the registry containing the names of individuals determined to have abused, neglected, misappropriated, or exploited the property of vulnerable individuals prior to hiring a future employee or allowing an individual to volunteer and prohibits anyone contained in the registry from being hired or otherwise provide services in the organization.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- The provisions of the bill as amended will apply to the regional mental health institutions (RMHIs), the Regional Intervention Program, and the agencies and service providers licensed by the Department of Mental Health. It will also apply to the residential, day, or supported employment providers contracted by the Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities.
- Requiring organizations to check the registry maintained by the Department of Health will not have a significant fiscal impact on the organizations or the maintenance and support of the registry.
