FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 799 – SB 836

April 8, 2011

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005801): Deletes the original bill. Authorizes the spotlighting of deer from a vehicle or vessel or with the aid of a motor vehicle or vessel if the light is directed onto land owned by the individual doing the spotlighting or if the individual has written permission to do so from the landowner. Prohibits the spotlighting of deer at any time from or on a public roadway.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption applied to amendment:

- According to the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, any change in the number of spotlight calls that the department responds to will be not significant. Any change in state or local expenditures will be not significant.
