FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 780 – HB 1380

April 11, 2011

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (005789): Deletes the language “no less than” in reference to the 90 days that a local government entity, official, or the state shall have to comply with a court order regarding violations of the Lawful Immigration Enforcement Act.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures – \$2,965,800/FY11-12
\$1,828,200/FY12-13 and Subsequent Years

Increase Local Revenue – \$100,000/Recurring
Increase Local Expenditures – Exceeds \$1,961,600/FY11-12*
\$961,600/FY12-13 and Subsequent Years*

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original bill.

Assumption applied to amendment:

- Deleting the language “no less than” will not change the number of days that a local government entity, official, or the state will have to comply with a court order.
