FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1243 – SB 1933

April 14, 2011

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (006242):** Designates the segment of State Route 68 in Monroe County between the corporate boundaries of Madisonville and Sweetwater as the *Bob 'Single Wing' Harrill Memorial Highway* and directs the Department of Transportation (TDOT) to manufacture and erect suitable signs. Designating signs shall be erected only if the cost of the manufacture and installation of signs is paid to TDOT from non-state funds within one year of the effective date of this bill.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Other Fiscal Impact – Not Significant to State and Local Government – However, to the extent that non-state funds are received from a local government, there will be a one-time, permissive increase in local government expenditures of \$300.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumption applied to amendment:

- The cost to manufacture and erect two (2) signs @ \$150.00 each is \$300.
