HB 1875 – SB 1951

April 27, 2011

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (007197): Deletes the original bill. Excludes from the definition of public or state records all electronic or mechanical devices or equipment used to create or store public or state records, including cell phones and computers.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Revenue – \$75,000

Increase Local Revenue – \$1,642,500/Permissive

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption applied to amendment:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 10-7-503(a)(1), the current definition of a public record does not include electronic or mechanical devices. Specifying that these items are not considered public or state record will not significantly affect state or local governments.
