FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1700 – SB 1851

May 9, 2011

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (007632): Deletes the original bill. Authorizes a person who owns less than 3,000 chickens and is licensed by the Department of Agriculture to sell all eggs produced by that person's chickens.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumptions applied to amendment:

- According to the Department of Agriculture, persons owning fewer than 3,000 chickens are regulated by state law, and currently pay a \$50 annual licensing fee.
- This bill will not create new responsibilities for the Department. Therefore, the fiscal impact to state government is not significant.
