**HB 1117 - SB 954**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Prohibits voting rights restoration for individuals who commit an act that is a felony in another state or under federal law that contains the same elements as the felonies described in Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 16, Parts 1, 4, or 5. Prohibits voting rights restoration for individuals who commit a sexual offense that is a felony in another state or under federal law that contains the same elements as the felonies described in Tenn. Code Ann. § 40-39-202, involving a minor victim.
