**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1472 - SB 1255**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Permanently expands the membership of the State Election Commission to seven members.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase State Expenditures - \$22,200**

Assumptions:

- The two members added by Chapter 376 of the Public Acts of 2009 were temporarily added without additional compensation or reimbursement during their temporary membership on the Commission. The new permanent members added by this bill will receive compensation and reimbursement for their service in addition to the compensation and reimbursement provided to the five existing members.
- The cost to add two regular members to the Commission will be \$22,168 per year [(\$750 monthly compensation + \$173.67 travel) x (12 months x 2 members)].
- Four members of the Commission will be members of the majority party, and three members of the Commission will be members of the minority party.
- The Commission will hold meetings each month.
