**HB 1633 - SB 1443**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Requires the first automated external defibrillator (AED) device received by a school to be placed in a location readily accessible from any area of the school, particularly those areas used for physical education or activity. Requires additional AEDs that are received to be placed in locations that are accessible in emergency situations.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- LEAs will not be required to purchase additional AEDs.
- Any increase in local expenditures to change the location of the first AED received by a school will be not significant.
