FISCAL NOTE

HB 1700 - SB 1851

March 4, 2011

SUMMARY OF BILL: Eliminates the requirements of washing and grading eggs for persons who sell less than 30 dozen eggs, produced by their own flocks, in a week. Requires the person's name and address to appear on the egg cartons along with the words "Ungraded Eggs." Requires the cartons to be clean, unbroken, and free of foreign odor, but not new.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 53-1-208(b), the affected egg producers are currently required to be licensed to sell unclassified eggs in Tennessee.
- According to the Department of Agriculture, because egg producers are still required to be licensed, the impact to state government will be not significant.
