HB 1889 - SB 1726

March 3, 2011

SUMMARY OF BILL: Expands the existing misdemeanor offense of production, manufacture, distribution, or possession of salvia divinorum A to include additional synthetic cannabinoids.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Currently, it is a Class A misdemeanor for a person knowingly to produce, manufacture, distribute, or possess with intent to produce, manufacture, or distribute the active chemical ingredient in the hallucinogenic plant salvia divinorum or the synthetic cannabinoids JWH-018, JWH-073, HU-210, and HU-211.
- There will not be a sufficient increase in the number of prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
