FISCAL NOTE

HB 2375 - SB 2237

January 14, 2012

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes the Department of Safety and Homeland Security to enter into partnership agreements with nonprofit organizations for the purpose of promoting and supporting goals of the Department. Defines certain requirements of the nonprofit organizations. Requires the nonprofit partners to submit a report to the Governor and the Speakers of the Senate and the House of Representatives detailing their operation and accomplishments within 90 days after the end of the fiscal year. The annual report and books of accounts and financial records are subject to audit by the Comptroller of the Treasury. The cost of any audit will be paid for by the nonprofit partner.
