FISCAL NOTE

HB 2638 - SB 2508

January 26, 2012

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a new Class C misdemeanor for a person to maintain living quarters on public property not designated or permitted for residential use; or for a person's use of, or assembly on, public property to pose a health hazard or threat to the safety and welfare of another person using, assembling on, or employed to work on that property. Subjects the violator to additional penalties including temporary or permanent removal from the property by law enforcement and liability for damage or depletion in value to the property.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- There will not be a sufficient number of misdemeanor prosecutions for state or local government to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
