FISCAL NOTE

HB 2664 - SB 2559

February 1, 2012

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires health care providers to report injuries that appear to result from illegal female genital mutilation to appropriate law enforcement officials and the district attorney general.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation adds an additional type of injury to the list of injuries that health care providers are currently required to report. This addition will not result in a significant regulatory or fiscal impact to the Department of Health (DOH) or health-related boards.
- Notification to health care providers of the provisions of this legislation can be accomplished through DOH's online newsletters and will not result in a significant fiscal impact.
- Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 4-3-1011, all health-related boards are required to be self-supporting over a two-year period. As of June 30, 2011, the Division of Health Related Boards had a balance of \$10,859,982.82.
