SUMMARY OF BILL: Increases, from 150 to 160 days per year, and from 75 to 80 days per semester, the time period a student must be present for classroom instruction before the student's record can be attributed to a specific teacher for the purposes of calculating the annual teacher effects on student progress.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- This change in time period may impact the number of students used in the teacher effect estimates; however, it will not result in a fiscal impact on state or local government.
