HB 3250 - SB 3019

SUMMARY OF BILL: Adds safety or security related positions to the list of employees that a public employer may require to undergo drug or alcohol testing as a routinely scheduled employee fitness-for-duty medical exam.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- Tenn. Code Ann. § 50-9-106 authorizes public employers to require scheduled periodic testing of police or peace officers, drug interdiction employees, employees authorized to carry firearms, employees engaged in activities affecting the safety of others, and employees working in contact with inmates.
- Public employers are already authorized to test safety and security related employees since these fall under the categories of employees currently authorized for testing; therefore, any fiscal impact on state or local governments will be not significant.
