FISCAL NOTE

HB 3550 - SB 3392

February 14, 2012

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Creates sunrise provision for the Energy Efficient Schools Council (EESC) on June 30, 2013. Expands the groups that may submit a list of qualified persons for appointment to the Council by the Speaker of the Senate to include interested contractor groups. Expands the groups that may submit a list of qualified persons for appointment to the Council by the Speaker of the House of Representatives to include interested architectural and engineering groups. Requires the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Speaker of the Senate respectively to consult with interested contractors or architectural or engineering groups when making their appointments.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The EESC will be under sunset review beginning on June 30, 2013.
- The EESC will continue as an existing entity at its current funding level.
- The EESC was appropriated \$36,673,300 in FY11-12.
- Funding in the amount of \$36,672,800 is included in the Governor's FY12-13 proposed budget.
- No change in the overall number of individuals appointed to the Energy Efficient Schools Council. No fiscal impact on state or local government.
