**FISCAL NOTE**

**SB 265**

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Designates the I-75 highway system within Tennessee as the *Tuskegee Airmen Memorial Trail* and directs the Department of Transportation (TDOT) to manufacture and erect suitable signs at the first available location at which the interstate highway enters Tennessee. Designating signs shall be erected only if the cost of the manufacture and installation of such signs is paid to TDOT by the county legislative body where such signs are installed within one year of the effective date of this bill.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**Increase Local Expenditures - \$300/One-Time/Permissive**

Assumptions:

- The cost to manufacture and erect two (2) signs @ \$150.00 each is \$300.
- One highway sign in Hamilton County and one highway sign in Campbell County would be required where I-75 enters Tennessee.
