SUMMARY OF BILL: Reduces, from three to two years, the time before a Chancery Court decree becomes final against a defendant upon whom personal service of process has not been made.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumption:

- Any increase in the number of final decrees against defendants will not be significant and will not have a significant impact on the case load of trial or appellate courts.
