FISCAL NOTE

SB 1397 - HB 1927

March 2, 2011

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a special joint committee to study the sources of funding for, the functions of, and the services provided by community service agencies, development districts, human resource agencies, and all other organizations providing community services statewide. Requires the Committee to report its findings and recommendations to the 107th General Assembly no later than February 1, 2012, at which time the Committee shall cease to exist.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$1,800/Each One-Day Meeting

Assumption:

- Travel and per diem expenses for the six legislative members appointed to the joint committee of \$1,817.76 per meeting (\$176 per diem plus \$126.96 mileage for each member).
