FISCAL NOTE

SB 2904 - HB 3231

March 2, 2012

SUMMARY OF BILL: Authorizes a county board of education, that has established a cooperative innovative high school program with one or more postsecondary institutions, to enter into agreements with other local education agencies (LEAs) in the same city or county so that the students in those LEAs may participate in the cooperative innovative high school program without having to establish one.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Other Fiscal Impact – Any increase in local revenue or expenditures is permissive and dependent upon the number of LEAs that wish to establish agreements with other LEAs to use their cooperative innovative high school program. This increase is not quantifiable.

Assumptions:

- Any LEA wishing to utilize the cooperative innovative high school program of another LEA will enter into an agreement authorizing the LEA to do so. Any agreement will be permissive.
- It is unknown if agreements will mandate that the LEA without the cooperative innovative program pay for its students to use the program. Any increase in local revenue or expenditures will be permissive and is not quantifiable.
