FISCAL NOTE

SB 3199 - HB 3436

February 5, 2012

SUMMARY OF BILL: Creates a special joint committee to study the provision of hazardous duty pay to state employees who perform potentially dangerous tasks or assignments. The committee shall consist of three members of the House of Representatives; three members of the Senate; the Commissioners (or designees) of Correction, Transportation, Human Services, Children's Services, and Human Resources; and one representative of the Tennessee State Employees Association. Requires the special joint committee to report its findings and recommendations to the 108th General Assembly no later than February 1, 2013, at which time the committee shall cease to exist.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Increase State Expenditures - \$1,800/Each One-Day Meeting

Assumptions:

- Travel and per diem expenses for six legislative members of \$1,799.96 per meeting (\$173 per diem plus \$126.96 mileage for each member).
- The non-legislative members of the committee will be from the Nashville area and will not require reimbursement for travel expenses.
