AMEND Senate Bill No. 1080*

House Bill No. 1098

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1.

(a) The commissioner of the Department of Environment and Conservation shall develop a proposal for a revised state implementation plan that eliminates motor vehicle inspection testing requirements mandated pursuant to title 55, and title 68, chapter 201 for all motor vehicles in this state that are three (3) or less model-years old.

(b) No later than January 1, 2014, the Commissioner shall report to the Speakers of the Senate and House of Representatives, the Senate Transportation and Safety Committee, the House of Representatives Transportation Committee, the Senate Commerce and Labor Committee, and the House of Representatives Business and Utilities Committee the details of the proposed revised state implementation plan, including but not limited to:

(1) A description of the specific controls or alternatives for specific controls that would be placed on other activities, businesses, industries, vehicles or individuals in any county in this state in order to replace the removal of tons of emissions or pollutants that may be added by eliminating motor vehicle emissions testing requirements mandated pursuant to title 55 and title 68, chapter 201 for all motor vehicles in this state that are three (3) or less model-years old; and

(2) An identification of Tennessee statutes that would need to be amended to implement the proposal developed pursuant to subsection (a).
