AMEND Senate Bill No. 1844\*

House Bill No. 1772

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and by substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 47, Chapter 50, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

**47-50-113.**

(a) When a vehicle is repossessed in this state, the individual, business or agency involved in the repossession may not abandon any personal property found in or on the vehicle for a period of fourteen (14) days following the repossession. If the owner reclaims the personal property within the fourteen-day period, then the owner shall be given possession without payment of any charges or fees.

(b) For purposes of this section:

(1) "Personal property" means any and all movable property not permanently affixed to the vehicle; and

(2) "Vehicle" includes any:

(A) Motor vehicle as defined in § 55-1-103;

(B) Aircraft as defined in § 42-2-101;

(C) Personal watercraft as defined in § 69-9-501;

(D) Boat as defined in § 69-3-103;

(E) Off-road vehicle as defined in § 47-25-1902;

(F) Farm tractor as defined in § 55-1-104;

(G) Tractor-drawn major farm implement subject to § 39-14-135;

(H) Industrial equipment operated by means of mechanical power  
upon which a person or property may be transported.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring  
it.
