AMEND Senate Bill No. 1634

House Bill No. 1430*

by adding the following new section immediately preceding the last section and by renumbering the subsequent section accordingly:

SECTION _____. By July 1, 2015, the administrative office of the courts (AOC) shall report to the general assembly on the effectiveness of this act. The report shall include information on how many people were served with injunctions against gang-related nuisances during the previous year, the number of those injunctions that were subsequently upheld by a court, the number of arrests for violations of those injunctions, and the outcomes of any criminal proceedings that arose from those arrests. The AOC shall consult with local law enforcement agencies in each jurisdiction that seeks to enforce injunctions on gang-related nuisances to obtain the number of individuals stopped due to suspected violations of criminal gang injunctions and how many of those stops resulted in arrests for violations of the injunctions, which shall also be included in the report. The report shall compare data in each of the above listed categories to comparable data from the previous two (2) years.
