AMEND Senate Bill No. 1110*

House Bill No. 1181

by deleting all language following the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 13, Part 1, is amended by adding a new section thereto, as follows:

39-13-115.

(a) A person who intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causes bodily injury to another at a public sporting event may be prohibited from entering the premises where such sporting event was held for two (2) years from the date of such bodily injury.

(b) A second offense of a person who intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causes bodily injury to another at a public sporting event may be punishable by prohibition from entering the premises where such sporting event was held for five (5) years from the date of such bodily injury.

(c) A third offense of a person who intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causes bodily injury to another at a public sporting event may be punishable by a lifetime prohibition from entering the premises where such sporting event was held.

(d) Subsections (a)-(c) shall be applicable even if a person who caused the bodily injury is not charged with assault under § 39-13-101, or aggravated assault under § 39-13-102.

(e) A person who enters or remains on a public sporting event premises after being prohibited from being on such premises pursuant to subsections (a)-(c) commits criminal trespass, and, upon conviction, shall be punished in accordance with § 39-14-405.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
