

HOUSE BILL 903

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57,  
Chapter 4 and Title 57, Chapter 5, relative to sales  
of beer at certain licensed establishments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-101(c)(1)(B), is amended by deleting subdivision (B) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

(B) May qualify for and hold a license:

(i) Under the provisions of chapter 4 of this title as a "restaurant" or "limited service restaurant"; provided, that notwithstanding title 57, chapter 4 related to restrictions or prohibitions on licensees under chapter 4, a restaurant or limited service restaurant may sell for off premises consumption beer manufactured pursuant to this section at such location or at any other restaurant or limited service restaurant licensed under chapter 4 that is owned by the same person; or

(ii) As a hotel as defined under § 57-4-102(20)(F)(iii); provided, that the hotel licensee shall only sell beer manufactured pursuant to this section on the premises of the hotel.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-203(e), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision (4):

(4) A restaurant or limited service restaurant may sell beer for consumption off premises upon meeting the requirements of § 57-5-101(c)(1)(B).

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-101(c)(1), is amended by deleting the language "or" at the end of subdivision (A) and by substituting instead the language "and".

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring  
it.
