

SENATE BILL 1410

AN ACT to repeal Chapter 221 of the Private Acts of 1992; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the privilege tax upon motor-driven vehicles, motorcycles, and motor-driven bicycles and scooters in McNairy County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 221 of the Private Acts of 1992; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the privilege tax upon motor-driven vehicles, motorcycles, and motor-driven bicycles and scooters in McNairy County, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the county legislative body of McNairy County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the county legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
