

SENATE BILL 2301

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 38, Chapter 6, Part 1; Title 39; Title 40; Section 42-1-203; Title 55 and Title 69, relative to testing for alcohol content.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-6-103(d)(2), is amended by deleting the word “breath” and substituting instead the words “breath or saliva”.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-6-103(g), is amended by deleting the word “breath” and substituting instead the language “breath, saliva”.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 42-1-203(a), is amended by deleting the word “breath” and substituting instead the language “breath, saliva”.

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-401(2), is amended by deleting the word “blood” and by substituting instead the language “blood, saliva”.

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-408(b), is amended by deleting the word “breath” and by substituting instead the language “breath or saliva”.

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-408(e), is amended by deleting the word “blood” and by substituting instead the language “blood, saliva”.

SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-409(b)(2)(B)(i), is amended by deleting the word “blood” and by substituting instead the language “blood, saliva”.

SECTION 8. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-411(h)(4), is amended by deleting the word “urine” and by substituting instead the language “urine, saliva”.

SECTION 9. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-413(d), is amended by deleting the language “breath, blood or urine” wherever it appears and by substituting instead the language “breath, blood, saliva or urine”.

SECTION 10. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-413(f)(1), is amended by deleting the language “blood or urine” and by substituting instead the language “blood, saliva or urine”.

SECTION 11. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-10-413(g)(1), is amended by deleting the language “blood or urine” and by substituting instead the language “blood, saliva or urine”.

SECTION 12. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 69-9-217(d)(2), is amended by deleting the language “urine” and by substituting instead the language “urine, saliva”.

SECTION 13. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, the public welfare requiring it.
