

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 114

A RESOLUTION commending United States Senator Lamar Alexander for his efforts to prevent the United States Army Corps of Engineers from restricting fishing access to sections of the Cumberland River near dams.

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly commend United States Senator Lamar Alexander for his efforts to introduce federal legislation preventing the United States Army Corps of Engineers from constructing physical barriers to restrict fishing access to sections of the Cumberland River located near United States Army Corps of Engineers Dams; and

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly encourage Senator Alexander to offer his legislation as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly encourage the United States Army Corps of Engineers to work with Senator Alexander and the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency on implementing a solution that addresses the concerns of Tennesseans and recognizes the dire economic impact the United States Army Corps of Engineers restrictions would have on the State of Tennessee; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we commend United States Senator Lamar Alexander for his efforts to prevent the United States Army Corps of Engineers from restricting fishing access to sections of the Cumberland River near dams and protecting the traditions of Tennessee anglers and their economic impact on the State of Tennessee.
