HJR 69

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Urges Congress to include emergency medical services personnel in the definition of “firefighter,” located at 29 U.S.C. 630(j). Further resolves that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the President, Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and Clerk of the United State House of Representatives, and each member of Tennessee’s Congressional delegation.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (003455): Urges Congress to classify emergency medical services personnel, in the definition of “emergency medical services” located at 29 U.S.C. 630(j) so that the scope of practice of emergency medical services personnel is included. Further resolves that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the President, Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and Clerk of the United State House of Representatives, and each member of Tennessee’s Congressional delegation.
