FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1116 – HB 910

March 18, 2013

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Requires the Department of Safety (DOS) to establish a database of emergency contacts of persons who hold driver licenses, learner permits, and identification cards. Establishes criteria by which the information may be used. Effective upon becoming law for purposes of promulgating rules and regulations; effective October 1, 2013 for all other purposes.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

Increase State Expenditures – \$458,800/FY13-14
\$447,700/FY14-15 and Subsequent Years

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004582): Adds language to the original bill that makes the bill as amended applicable only to driver licenses issued or renewed after the completion of the Department of Safety's license modernization project, provided that sufficient funds are appropriated in the General Appropriations Act to meet the funding required for implementation. Makes the bill effective upon becoming law.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- According to the Department of Safety, the license modernization project is scheduled for completion between January and July of 2015.
- The provisions of this bill as amended are included in the project.
- Applying the provisions only to those licenses issued or renewed after this project is implemented will eliminate the fiscal impact to the Department.
