FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1223 – SB 1295

March 19, 2013

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Authorizes the court to award reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees and disbursements, if there is a finding that a party to a proceeding brought under the wage regulation law did not act in good faith.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (004719): Deletes all language after the enacting clause. Deletes language from wage regulation law that states the amount agreed upon for wages shall constitute a basis for litigation in civil cases. Requires the Department of Labor and Workforce Development to enforce wage regulations.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- According to the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, there will be no impact on the operations of the Department.
