**FISCAL MEMORANDUM**

**SB 1777 – HB 1952**

February 26, 2014

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Prohibits the use of drones to conduct video surveillance of private citizens who are lawfully hunting or fishing. Such use would be classified as a Class C misdemeanor.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (012825):** Deletes and re-writes subdivision (a)(6) of Section 3 of the bill to require written consent of persons being surveilled prior to conducting drone assisted surveillance of private citizens who are lawfully hunting or fishing.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- The written consent provision in the bill as amended will not result in any change to the fiscal impact of the original bill.
- There will not be a significant number of prosecutions for state or local governments to experience any significant increase in revenue or expenditures.
