FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1940 – HB 1871

March 5, 2014

**SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL:** Requires local education agencies (LEAs) within counties that have certain teen pregnancy rates to send additional information on the LEAs' family life curriculum to the state. Requires such LEAs to send a list of their specific family life curriculum, and information about the person, non-LEA employee, or organization that teaches the course, to the Department of Education (DOE) and the State Board of Education (SBE).

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

**SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (013407):** Deletes all language of the original bill. Changes the definition of gateway sexual activity for the purpose of the family life curriculum; deletes requirement that family life curriculum exclusively promote sexual risk avoidance through abstinence; and requires family life curriculum to specify that education on sexually transmitted diseases include HIV/AIDS.

**FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

**Unchanged from the original fiscal note.**

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- Any increase in state or local expenditures to update the family life curriculum in accordance with this amendment is estimated to be not significant.
