FISCAL MEMORANDUM

SB 1891 – HB 1774

April 9, 2014

SUMMARY OF ORIGINAL BILL: Urges those authorities responsible for appointing members to the Private Probation Services Council to strive to ensure the council is composed of members who are diverse.

FISCAL IMPACT OF ORIGINAL BILL:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENT (015845): Deletes all language after the enacting clause.

Prohibits any public officer or employee of a governing authority from deriving any direct benefit from a contract if the officer or employee is involved in making or administering a contract with a private entity that is governed by the Private Probation Services Council and that entity provides probation services.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL WITH PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Unchanged from the original fiscal note.

Assumption for the bill as amended:

- The proposed legislation will not significantly impact the State or local governments.
