SUMMARY OF BILL: Codifies into state law the renaming of the Cumberland Trail State Park to the “Justin P. Wilson – Cumberland Trail State Park”, as provided in Executive Order No. 33 of 2002.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to the Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), some brochures have been printed referencing the park as the Cumberland Trail State Park. It is assumed that new forms bearing the official park name would only be printed after exhausting the current supply of brochures. Therefore, any increase in printing costs is considered not significant.
- Any existing signage that does not have the “Justin P. Wilson” designation will be replaced with appropriately termed signage at such time as the signs would have been replaced in the regular course of business.
