HB 314 - SB 559

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits the use of unmanned traffic enforcement cameras on Highway 11E in Bluff City.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Decrease Local Revenue - \$261,400/Bluff City

Assumptions:

- According to information provided by Bluff City, there are two traffic enforcement cameras on Highway 11E; each has been in operation since January, 2012.
- According to Bluff City, actual revenue collected from camera citations issued over a seven-month period (from July 1, 2012, through January 31, 2013) totaled \$152,500.
- Prohibition from using such unmanned traffic enforcement cameras will result in a recurring decrease in local government revenue estimated to be \$261,429 [(\$152,500 / 7-month period) x 12-month year].
