FISCAL NOTE

HB 712 - SB 979

February 15, 2013

SUMMARY OF BILL: Requires hospitals, between August 1 and March 31 of each year, to distribute information on influenza disease and the availability of a vaccine to protect against the influenza virus. Such information is to be distributed to patients six months and older and may be distributed to the legal guardians of patients aged six months through eighteen years of age.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- It is assumed that the majority of hospitals, including public, private, and non-profit, have this information readily available for distribution.
- Any increase in costs for any hospital owned or supported by a government, state or local, is estimated to be not significant.
- The bill specifies that the requirements do not constitute a requirement to be assessed during any hospital inspections by the Department of Health. Therefore, the Department will not incur any additional expenditure.
