FISCAL NOTE

HB 953 - SB 1176

February 23, 2013

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Authorizes the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and Insurance to set maximum inspection fees for services rendered by deputy electrical inspectors and manufactured home or travel trailer inspectors.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- Deputy electrical inspectors and manufactured home or travel trailer inspectors are paid a fee to inspect electrical installations by a property owner, an electrical contractor, or any person, association, or corporation that provides electrical energy to such installations.
- Allowing the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce and Insurance to set maximum inspection fees will likely change the amount such inspectors are paid for performance of inspections; however, it is estimated that any subsequent increase or decrease in any such fees will result in no significant fiscal impact to state or local government.
