FISCAL NOTE

HB 1059 - SB 1290

March 17, 2013

SUMMARY OF BILL: Prohibits state and local governmental entities, employees of state and local government entities, members of the Tennessee National Guard, members of the Tennessee State Guard, and members of the Civil Air Patrol, from providing assistance to the United States armed forces in the investigation, prosecution or detention of any United States citizen, pursuant to section 1021 of the National Defense Authorization Act for fiscal year 2012, if such assistance would place such entities, or personnel of such entities, in violation of the United States Constitution, Tennessee's Constitution, or any state law.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

Assumption:

- Such prohibition would have no fiscal impact upon the State.
