**FISCAL NOTE**

**HB 1503 - SB 2083**

February 16, 2014

**SUMMARY OF BILL:** Defines “offender against children” for purposes of the sex offender registry as a sexual offender, violent sexual offender, or violent juvenile sexual offender if the victim in one or more of the offender’s crimes was 13 years old or younger. Requires one classified as an offender against children to remain on the registry for life.

Makes the fact that a registrant is an offender against children public information.

**ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:**

**NOT SIGNIFICANT**

Assumptions:

- The proposed legislation will not result in an increase of registrants required to register, as an offender against children is already a sex offender.
- Altering the amount of time an individual remains on the registry will not significantly impact state revenue or expenditures.
