FISCAL NOTE

HB 1668 - SB 1773

January 30, 2014

SUMMARY OF BILL: Deletes current definition of home school student for the purpose of receiving a HOPE lottery scholarship. Defines home school student as a student who completed high school in a Tennessee home school meeting the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 49-6-3050(a)(2) or (3) or § 49-6-3050(b). In order to meet the definition of a home school student, a student must have been educated in a home school for at least one year prior to graduating high school.

ESTIMATED FISCAL IMPACT:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions:

- According to the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation, there will be no change in the number of home school students who will receive HOPE scholarships.
- No fiscal impact on state expenditures.
